Kalamazoo Hamfest Wrap Up

Another year has passed and another successful Hamfest is in the books. First up, I want to thank all the volunteers and committee members who made the event possible. Without your selflessness and willingness to step up and help plan, coordinate, and advertise, the event simply wouldn't be possible.

This year was a big gamble for us as we made a lot of changes that increased the cost of running the event. We changed from our typical Sunday to a Saturday earlier in the month, we expanded available space into a the north expo hall, and extended hours until 4pm from our regular noon closing time. All these changes were made based on the feedback from both the Amateur Radio community as well as the Michigan Antique Radio Club\Vintage Electronics Expo community, who we partnered with again this year.

While we have not tallied the official numbers yet, things look promising. We sold roughly 80% of our 240 total tables and had roughly 400-450 attendees this year. That's a big increase over last year! We had several great presentations that were well received as well as a host of great door prizes given out. For those interested in the answer to how many vacuum tubes were in the jar, the answer was 707!

We've had some great reports about the event on some of the local 40 and 80 meter HF nets. We're already in talks with the expo center to move forward with the same weekend and format again next year.
