It is with great sadness that we report the passing of Ken Irish, Jr, W8JVP.

Ken graduated from WMU's ROTC program, going on to serve in the US Army Signal Corps for 26 years, rising to the rank of Colonel.

Ken was a lifelong radio enthusiast, volunteer, and community member. He received his own call sign (K8SXH) at an early age and upon his father's passing took over his call (W8JVP). Ken was a founding member of Radio Amateur Society of Thailand (RAST) in 1963 and helped mentor some of the first amateur operators of that country.

Locally Ken has been a longtime member and volunteer with in the club. Over the years taking on various roles on the board and at events. Ken has been serving with the club's Board of Directors for the last 3 years and has been an active volunteer and contributor at Field Day, the Fall Bike Celebration, and the Kalamazoo Hamfest. He always brought an enthusiasm for mentoring others and helping folks get on the air.
